COVID-19 Update Tuesday 24th March – Arrangement and Changes to Provision

Dear Parent/Carer

South Lanarkshire Council has decided to update their arrangements for provision for category 1 and category 2 workers that will be put in place over the next few days. Detailed below are the arrangement for this week and the foreseeable future.

- **Tuesday 24th March and Wednesday 25th March** - Calderglen will be closed for all pupils except children with parents of category 1+2 workers as detailed below:
 - Category 1 – Health and Care workers directly supporting COVID response, and associated staff; Health and Care workers supporting life threatening emergency work, as well as critical primary and community care provision; Energy suppliers (small numbers identified as top priority already); staff providing childcare/learning for other category 1 staff (including all teachers, other staff and facilities staff in educational settings)
 - Category 2 – (police, fire and rescue, ambulance, prison service)
- **Thursday 26th March onwards** – South Lanarkshire Council will start a hub model for provision for children with parents of category 1+2 workers. Calderglen's local hub will be St Hilary's Primary School (the primary directly across from Calderglen High). Below is the necessary information for parents to access this provision:
 - There will be a central application process for hubs managed by Education Resources. Eligibility criteria will be detailed in the application form so parents are aware of this as they apply for a place.
 - The initial deadline for parental returns is [9am on Wed 25th March 2020](#). HQ will manage this process including notifying parents directly
